### Course Outline

An interactive classroom session, where the most common driving errors are discussed and drivers are shown how to identify the potential for a situation to develop and how to manage it. This multimedia session includes a PowerPoint presentation and video footage of actual incidents where the factors leading up to the event will be discussed. This session is designed to be thought provoking and drivers are encouraged to give their own opinions on how a particular situation may have been dealt with or foreseen. The course content can be tailored to include specific subject matter relevant to the organisation and their fleet policy. Course material also includes Driving in Adverse Conditions and Vehicle Technology Information, which covers ABS, Traction Control, Stability Programme, Emergency Brake Assist, Fatigue Monitors and other driver aids coming on stream which drivers may not be aware of.

In addition there will be an On-Road training element where the trainer will identify areas for enhancement and harness existing driving skills. The driver will be in their normal work vehicle and this element is conducted in an informal manner with a view to provoking thought and raising their awareness of the driving environment. Checks will be conducted prior to drive commencing ensuring the driver knows what to check in order to ensure the vehicle is in proper working order.
