IWEA safety poster campaign

•Edition 1. January.February2013

•Edition_2._ prepared in draft form but not published

•Some suggestions

- Reduce the level of resource to prepare each poster
- Produce in A4 portrait format for use in site toolbox talks & site inductions
- Reduce amount of text in poster, cover less items in each poster
- Produce themed posters that highlight key risks, and avoid references to calendar dates etc. so posters are 'timeless'
- Make draft 'best practice' toolbox talks available to accompany each theme
- Distribute hard copies to all PSDP and PSCS / CDM-C, Principal Contractors for display on wind farm sites
- Use separate simple A4 template to distribute near-miss information to sites quickly (same circulation list)
